



Web Accessibility Statement

Pamlico Community College (PCC) is committed to making its electronic and information technologies accessible to people with disabilities. Both new and existing web content produced by our organization will meet [W3C Web Content Accessibility Guidelines \(WCAG\)](#) by June 30, 2018.

This information applies to all web content produced or updated by Pamlico Community College. In addition, PCC is taking the following steps to ensure accessibility of content provided by third-party developers:

- Providing a “Requirements of ADA Compliance” to third-party vendors which clearly outline accessibility expectations.
- Ensuring all instructional materials (books, PowerPoint presentations, etc.) have ADA compliant alternatives available;
- Informing third-party developers of PCC's policy on web accessibility;
- Providing links to information and resources on implementing web accessibility;
- Monitoring and providing feedback on inaccessible third-party content.

This information will be reviewed annually on or before May 1st by the department or division responsible for the content. All new content that is published will be subject to accessibility checks as part of the publishing workflow.
