Comments:

Certified Nursing Assistant requirements vary by state and other individual factors, credentials, training, and job experience. It's important to note that not all states have reciprocity agreements or requirements.

If you are moving to another state without a reciprocity agreement, you will have to retake the certification exam for that state.

Student applications are reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Requirements vary in each of the 50 states for the Certified Nursing Assistant program.

Upon successful completion of the CNA I course and the certification exam, the student will be listed on the North Carolina Division of Health Service Regulation Nurse Aide I Registry.

CNAs are covered under reciprocity AND the Nurse Licensure Compact (NLC). Because of this, CNAs can move from most states to other states with relative ease.
