- 3) A \*qualifying person lived with you in the home for more than half the year (except for temporary absences such as attending school).

#### \*A qualifying person is:

- 1) Your child or grandchild who lived with you more than half the year and is single or is married but still someone you can claim as an exemption or
- 2) the tax filer's mother or father, if the taxpayer claims the mother/father as an exemption or
- 3) another relative who lives with the taxpayer more than half the year **and** the taxpayer claims the relative as an exemption

## You are considered separated/divorced if you meet the following requirement:

1) Your spouse did not live in your home during the last 6 months of the tax year.

### **Parent Instructions:**

If your parent(s) should not have filed 2022 IRS income tax returns as "Head of Household":

- 1. File amended 2022 IRS income tax return
- 2. Submit both of the following to our office:
  - a. A 2022 IRS Tax Return Transcript (signature not required) OR a <u>signed</u> copy of the 2022 Income Tax Return and All Schedules completed; AND
  - b. A **signed** copy of the 2022 IRS Form 1040X, "Amended U.S. Individual Income Tax Return", that was filed with the IRS
