Comments: Medication Aide requirements vary by state and factor in other individual factors; including credentials, training, and job experience. It's important to note that not all states have reciprocity agreements or requirements. All states that have approved this position mandate certification.

Medication Aides must have successfully completed an instructor training program or course approved by the NC Board of Nursing.

Students who successfully complete the program or course are eligible to take the Medication Aide Examination to qualify for listing on the North Carolina Medication Aide Registry.

Student applications are reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

Some states use different terminology for 'Medication Aide', including:

- **Medication Assistant**
- **Certified Medication Assistant (CMA)1**
- **Qualified Medication Administration Personnel**
- **Medication Technician**
- **Trained Medication Assistant**
